2019 Majors/AAA Division Inter League Rules

- 1. The 2019 Majors/AAA Inter-league shall consist of teams from: Vista National, Vista America, Oceanside Valley and Rancho Buena Vista Little Leagues for Majors and AAA.
- 2. Home field shall be responsible for providing umpires.
- 3. Home field will begin the field prep. When the visiting team arrives and the field prep is not complete, the visiting team will help out with completing field prep.
- 4. Infield Warm ups
 - a. Infield Warmup is not guaranteed
 - b. Infield warmup is at the discretion of the BMOD based on field availability
 - c. Visiting team shall have 10 minutes of Infield warm up 30 minutes prior to scheduled game time
 - d. Home team shall have 10 minutes of Infield warm up 20 minutes prior to scheduled game time
- 5. At 10 minutes prior to the scheduled start time of the game; all players shall be in their respective dugouts for the purpose of umpire pre-game management duties.
 - a. All equipment shall be out of bags for umpire inspection.
- 6. Home team shall supply scorekeeper and pitch counter
- 7. Home Teams provide game balls
- 8. **RBVLL** No gum or sun flower seeds in the dug outs or fields
- 9. VALL-No gum or sunflower seed in the dug outs or field
- 10. **OVLL-**No gum or sunflower seeds in the dug outs or fields
- 11. **RBVLL**-Saturday's ONLY batting cages is available 90 minutes prior to game time for the visiting teams for 30 minutes. 60 minutes prior to game time for home teams for 30 minutes. Both teams should be on the field 30 minutes prior to game time.
- 12. **VNLL** -Batting cages between Field 1 & 2 **(1 tunnel per team)** are available 90 minutes prior to game time for the visiting teams for 30 minutes. 60 minutes prior to game time for home teams for 30 minutes. Both teams should be on the field 30 minutes prior to game time.
- 13. Oceanside Valley and Vista America no batting cages available
- 14. Each team will be responsible for cleaning dugout after each game.
- 15. Each team manager is required to carry a current and up to date Pitchers Log. This log is to be signed by the pitch counter and each manager after each and every game. 30 minutes prior to the start time, each manager shall present their pitching log to the scorekeeper or opposing manager. Games will not start unless each team has provided their pitching log. Failure to comply results in the following: 1st offense written warning to the manager, 2nd offense 2-game suspension for the Manager, 3rd offense removal of manager from team. Offenses are to be reported to DA Rattermann.
- 16. Pool players can only be brought into a game to cap a team 10 players. The local league's player agent will manage the pool.
- 17. Continuous Batting Order will be in effect for all interleague games

Timing

- All games will be terminated at 9:45, and the final score determined per LL rule 4.11 (d).
- (AAA) During regular season play the final inning for the game will be the inning that begins after 1 hour and 40 minutes has elapsed on the game clock.
- 5 run rule applies for AAA Division Games . (NO OPEN INNINGS)
